## BPMB Provides RM374 Million Financing for Perlis Inland Port

**15th Jan 2024 Kuala Lumpur:** Bank Pembangunan Malaysia Berhad (BPMB) approved Tawarruq Asset Financing Facilities amounting to RM374 million to finance the construction of Perlis Inland Port (PIP).

Roni Abdulwahab, Group Chief Executive Officer of Bank Pembangunan stated, "This project is part of our dedication to catalyse positive change and progress, in line with our purpose of delivering impact capital for national development. Perlis Inland Port is a Public Private Partnership under 12th Malaysia Plan and National Transportation Plan 2030, to achieve Government's MADANI aspirations. It also complements New Industrial Master Plan 2030."

Dato' Shabaruddin Ibrahim, Group Executive Chairman of Mutiara Perlis Sdn Bhd said, "This financing from BPMB is a crucial step towards achieving Perlis Inland Port project" which he felt would greatly benefit the economy of Perlis and Malaysians.

Upon completion, the project is expected to generate 520 direct and 3,500 indirect employment opportunities, with over 80% of these positions designated for the local community.

The project is to be developed in three phases with Phase 1 anticipated to commence operations in the first quarter of 2025. Upon successful completion of all three phases, the cross border multi modal inland port will boast state-of-the-art infrastructure capable of handling up to 2 million Twenty-foot Equivalent Units (TEU) per annum.

**18 Jan 2024 Hatyai:** Penang Port Sdn Bhd (PPSB) organised its annual South Thailand Customer Appreciation Dinner at Centara Hotel, Hat Yai, Thailand to honour the enduring business relationships with its valued customers from South Thailand.

## ESG - Rainwater Harvesting (RWH) Blueprint

PIP prioritises the conservation and management of water resources, to ensure compliance with its ESG objectives.

While water consumption is increasing in Malaysia by 7.6 liters per capita/ annum, water reserves are decreasing by 5.8 liters per capita/ annum. By 2025 Malaysia is expected to see water shortages. Bearing in mind that Perlis water resources are stretched already, PIP has developed a RWH policy that will capture all the roof water from Warehouses and other structures that will yield relatively clean water for use.




Water is a limited resource for Perlis state. Perlis receives 2000 mm (78 inches) of rain annually which for the PIP is a potential resource that it can capture to mitigate flooding and to provide an alternative to municipal water. In 2020 Perlis the domestic per capita liter water consumption rate per day (LCD) was 244 and it increased to 251 liters (55 gallons/day) by 2021, which is relatively high, compared with the UN benchmark of daily water requirement at 165 liters per person/ day.

In PIP Phase 1, warehousing of 100,000 sq ft should be able to supply clean water around 2.95 million liters per annum.

## PIP Internal Infrastructure Construction Progress


**31 Mar 2024 Lembah Chuping:** EPC contractor Citaglobal Land Sdn Bhd (subsidiary of Citaglobal Berhad) has reported that construction progress at PIP was currently at 26%. Majority of the site clearance and earthworks have been completed. The main feature of progress was the construction of container yard platform including slab, drainage & electrical infrastructure works.
