27th May 2025 Kuala Lumpur: At Lao-Malaysia Business Forum, Prime Minister Sonexay Siphandone highlighted Lao potential in agriculture, green energy, and digital tourism for participants to

explore new opportunities in trade corridors linking Southern China to Malaysia via Lao and Thailand. Mutiara Perlis delegation headed by Dato Shabaruddin Ibrahim briefly met with PM H.E. Sonexay and partners to advance logistics synergies for movement of cargoes between Lao and Malaysia. 20th May 2025 Kuala Lumpur & Padang Besar: Mutiara Perlis hosted JR Freight and Sri Trang to develop a groundbreaking Thailand-Malaysia cargo route via Padang Besar Container Terminal and the future Perlis Inland Port (PIP). The passage will be launched soon by using Sri Trang as (Thai agent) and Infinity as (Malaysian agent), following detailed operational reviews and site inspections of PIP's rail capabilities. This initiative positions PIP as a vital ASEAN trade hub, potentially transforming regional supply chains with faster and more efficient cross-border movement. They expressed interest in PIP's multi modal connectivity especially rail connections to Penang and Klang. LTS even handle their own maintenance at their operation yard in Penang.



As of June 2025, the PIP internal infrastructure has reached 85% completion. Meanwhile, external infrastructure works stand at 93% for the rail spur line and flyover, and 100% for the bonded road. Mutiara Perlis is excited and fully focused on the upcoming opening scheduled for July 2025.
